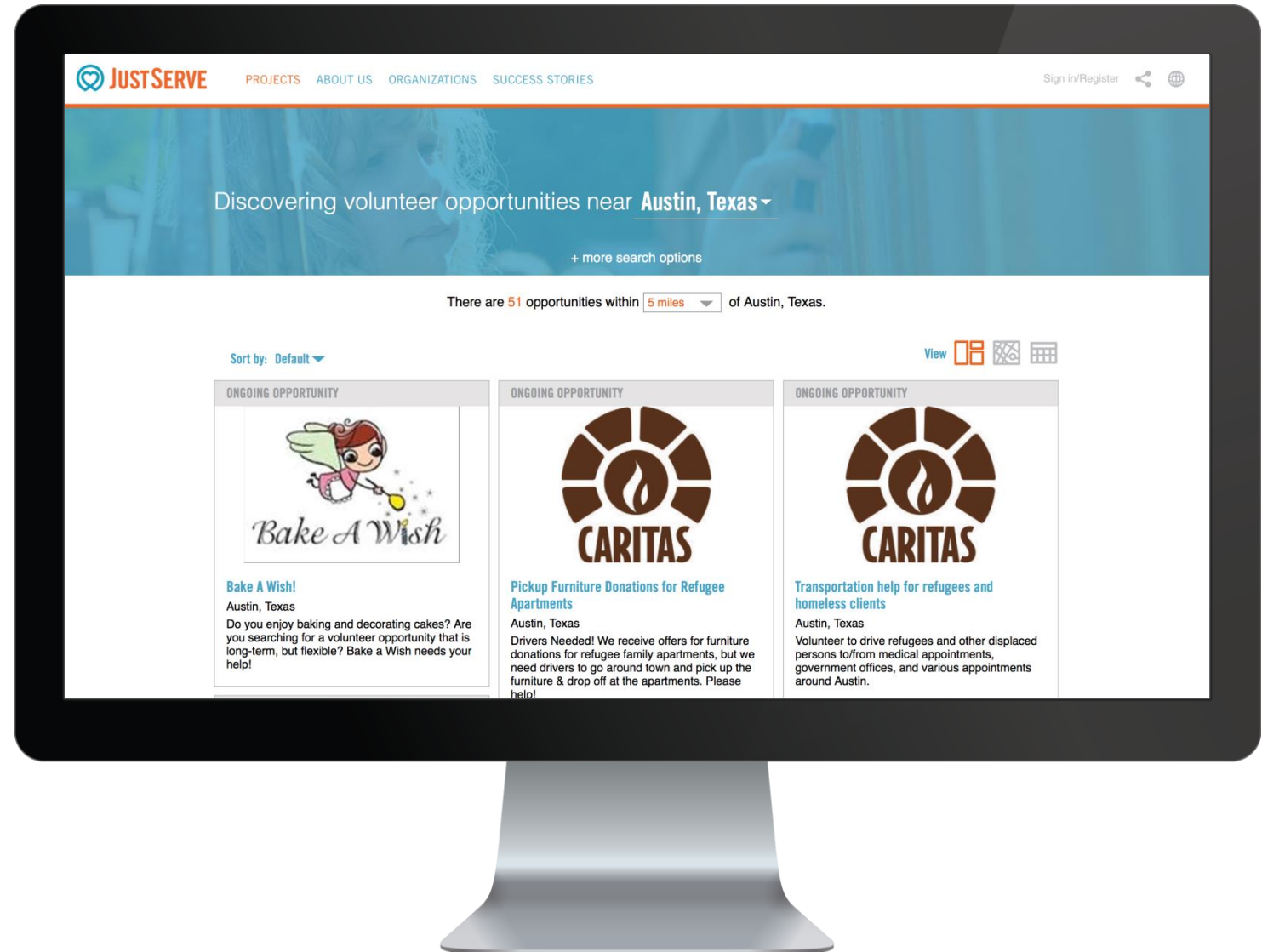
# How do I sign up?
