What is a CASA Volunteer?



- Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA)
- A voice for a child in foster care
- Consistent adult in the child's case until a safe and stable forever home is found
- A volunteer with CASA of Maricopa County



Impact of a CASA Volunteer

- Perform **better** in school
- Spend **less time** in foster care
- Experience **fewer** placements
- Receive **more** court-ordered services
- Services are more carefully targeted
& **received sooner**
- **Less likely** to re-enter care

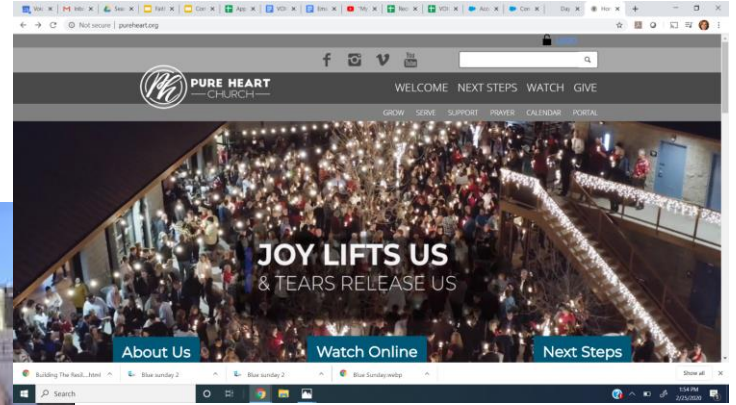
